The Telecom Australia and Telstra Coca-Cola Phonecards and Packs (Continued)

Third Release: Coca-Cola The 'Gal' Pack, and Coca-Cola The 'Guy' Pack

In the September 1995 issue of the Australian Phonecard Monthly Vol. 3 No. 9 (Refer to https://www.sergent.com.au/phonecards/aust/apm03-09.html) on the front cover and on pages 23 to 26, the Universal Coin Co. advertised the third release Coca-Coca 'Gal' and Coca-Cola 'Guy' Standard Packs. A Standing Order Arrangement Form (SOA) was located on page 26 and it listed the same information as the SOA for the first Release Coca-Cola Packs except for the following:

- There was a box to place the Order Quantity (but with no limit specified) for each of the Coca-Cola The 'Guy' Standard Pack (Only 4,000 Produced, and \$24.50 each), and the Coca-Cola The 'Gal' Standard Pack (Only 4,000 produced and \$24.50 each), and
- The Standing Order Arrangement offer would close on 15 October 1995.

There were 300 of each of the Coca-Cola 'Gal' Gold Packs and Coca-Cola 'Guy' Gold Packs released, and they were priced at \$69 per matched pair (= \$34.50 each), as advertised under 'Coca-Cola Series 5, The Roaring 20s' and 'Australian Custom Card Packs' in the International Numismatics Phonecard Bulletin No. 18, May 1996. Therefore, there were actually only 3,700 (= 4,000 - 300) of each of these Standard Packs produced.

NOTE: Pack No. 0230 is presently the highest numbered Gold Pack sighted, while Pack No. 342 is the lowest numbered Standard Pack sighted. Could any reader of this Newsletter who has a Coca-Cola 'Gal' Gold Pack and/or a Coca-Cola 'Guy' Gold Pack with a Pack Number higher than 230, and/or a Coca-Cola 'Gal' Standard Pack and/or a Coca-Cola 'Guy' Standard Pack with a Pack Number lower than 342, please provide the Editor with a scan, photo or copy of the back of that/those pack(s) showing its Pack No. similar to the images shown on the right?





Summary of Third Release Coca-Cola Pack Details

The Third Release Gold & Standard Coca-Cola Packs (i.e. The 'Gal' Packs, and The 'Guy' Packs) contained Phonecards which had their Card Number matched to the Pack Number as follows;








