

The *Bulletin* also contains news on the Official Issue and Advertising card releases and 'Blast from the Past' looks at the cards released for the 1992 Olympic Games in Spain. Are you one of the lucky ones who has these cards included in your collection?

NEW RELEASES

OFFICIAL ISSUES

One new Official Issue and one Limited Edition folder is available for sale in this issue of the *Bulletin*.

Australia is surrounded by vast oceans, the home of a myriad of spectacular forms of underwater life. The beauty and kaleidoscope of colours these creatures possess cannot be matched anywhere in the world. Australia's treasured marine life has been recognised by Telstra and highlighted in the new Marine Series.

The Marine Series individual cards - two \$5, one \$10 and one \$20 - and Limited Edition folder are available for sale in this issue of the *Bulletin*. The Limited Edition folder includes a \$2 Promotional card specially produced to be included in the folder. This card **will not** be available for sale individually. 4,000 folders have been produced and are available for \$54.00.

ADVERTISING AND PROMOTIONAL RELEASES

Telstra will be releasing four Advertising cards for Helen Curtis promoting Finesse Shampoo. The cards feature a promotion in conjunction with Sportsgirl to win prizes. See Finesse promotional packs for details of the competition. There are four cards in this series - two \$5, one \$10 and one \$20 - which will be released nationally from late April.

Telstra's attendance at the Royal Easter Show in Sydney has been commemorated with 6,000 \$5 Telstra **Phonecards**. Featuring the 1996 Royal Easter Show's mascots - the rooster, cow and pig - this card carries the *Promotional* card code. 4,000 Telstra **Phonecards** were sold at the Telstra Payphone Services' stand at the Show. A further 2,000 cards

will be available to Collectors with a Standing Order Arrangement for Advertising cards.

UPCOMING RELEASES

The June issue of the *Bulletin* will coincide with the release of the Olympic series. This series features the Olympic teams sponsored by Telstra - Hockeyroos (women's hockey), Titans (weight lifting) and Dolphins (swimming). There will be 4,000 Limited Edition folders produced and they will contain one \$5, \$10 and \$20 Telstra **Phonecards**.

PHONEAWAY™

Telstra is introducing a new and improved prepaid calling card - PhoneAway. PhoneAway can be used to make local, STD and international calls from virtually any telephone in Australia and to call Australia from more than 30 overseas countries.

PhoneAway cards are available in denominations of \$10, \$20, \$50 and \$100, with the first releases featuring striking Australian landscape scenes.

PhoneAway is a great idea for the budget conscious traveller and is also a novel gift for a loved one on the other side of the country or a relative 'back home'.

To use it in Australia, you simply dial an access number (1819), which is packaged with the card, then dial the identification number on the reverse of the card and then your phone number. A recorded voice announcement takes the caller through the process. To use it overseas, you dial the respective countries' access number then follow the same procedure.

PhoneAway will be available from late June from Telstra **Phonecard** Collector Service, or can be purchased from Telstra Shops, newsagencies, domestic and international airports and travel outlets. For details of charges, call FREECALLTM 1800 068 106 (calls from mobile phones are charged at mobile rates) from Australia and from overseas, reverse charges +61 3 9203 2493

The PhoneAway cards will not be part of the Standing Order.

Phone Away will replace Phone Australia. Phone Australia cards sold to date can still be used as intended.

ISSUING POLICY

The **Phonecard** Design Approval Committee have recently amended the issuing policy for Official (National) Issue Telstra **Phonecards**. Following is an excerpt from the new Issuing Policy.

"The primary objective of the Telstra **Phonecard** is to provide payment for telephone calls. Each issue of telephone card will be determined by telephone service requirements, commercial demand, production parameters and the design subject matter.

The following will be excluded as design subjects for Official Issue Telstra **Phonecard** and associated peripheral stationery and products:

- anniversaries other than those of national significance;
- anniversaries of the death of any individual;
- subjects with interest to a narrow section of the community, region, state or territory;
- anniversaries of the founding of a city, town or local government body unless national significance;
- anniversaries of events connected with religious organisations, political parties or groups, and subjects likely to cause community decisiveness;
- periodic events, including festivals, except Australia Day and Christmas/ New Year season, Telstra historical events, and major telecommunication events;
- products and services except Telstra Corporate advertising or promotion."
