Telstra has released five promotional Phonecards on behalf of Frontline - the company who keeps our Australian Army and Airforce personnel stocked up with their essentials.

Individual cards are available **exclusively** through Frontline canteens on Australian Army and Airforce bases. However, Telstra has negotiated an extra 3,000 cards to be made available for collectors through the Telstra **Phonecard** Collector Service.

There are 2 X \$5, 2 x \$10 and a \$20 denomination cards in the series.

These stunning images capture the courage, determination and technology of Australia's defence forces.



A lso released in June are six advertising cards produced for the tourist industry. Packaged in an attractive folder, this Tourist Pack features popular Australian icons such as Uluru and native Australian animals. Sold through tourist outlets, the Pack is aimed at encouraging tourists to use and collect Telstra **Phonecard** while they travel throughout Australia. The Pack also acts as a souvenir of their visit to Australia.

An additional 5,000 loose cards are offered **exclusively** to collectors through the Telstra **Phonecard** Collector Service from June.

#### Auscard '96

As part of the Auscard '96 exhibition, Telstra donated four framed, special edition Phonecards to raise money for the Wesley Central Mission.

The Telstra **Phonecard** displays included the Hong Kong '95, Singapore '95, Cardex'95 and Indo-Phonecards '95, individually signed by the Telstra representatives who attended these exhibitions.

The sale of these displays raised close to \$1,500, which will help the Mission with their valuable work.



### Blast from the past

Not only is Telstra **Phonecard** a great way to make cashless calls from payphones, but it is also a fantastic way to celebrate a special occasion.

At the end of each year, Telstra produces a special **Phonecard** series to celebrate what Christmas means to all Australians.

In 1992, the **Phonecard** series showed our native animals living it up in a classic summertime fashion. These striking designs were created by Vincent de Gouw, AdGraphics, and featured a \$5 and \$10 card.

Also included was a complimentary \$1.50 card which was mounted on a special card and distributed free to mail order customers.

### **Destruction Figures**

Telstra's attendance at the Auscard '96 fair was celebrated with the special production of a \$5 **Phonecard** featuring an image of the Sydney Opera House. 2,000 of this design were produced and were sold at the fair in April. The remaining 574 unsold cards and folders have now been destroyed.

Also specially produced for the Hong Kong exhibition last December, was the Chinese Year of the Rat folder.

1,500 of these were produced and 691 of the remaining, unsold stock have since been destroyed.

### Geelong Series Refund Campaign

The refund period for the Geelong Phonecard series is running out.

Produced over five years ago, this series contains \$1.50, \$3 and \$6 denomination cards, which can no longer be used in public payphones.

To receive a refund, simply fill in a **Phonecard** refund form (available from any shop or outlet selling **Phonecard**) and send it to the refund centre in the Reply Raid envelope provided.

Please send refund form to the refund centre and not to the Phonecard Collector Service.

It is recommended that you send the refund form into Telstra, rather than receive a refund from a **Phonecard** retailer.

Please note: This recall campaign will end close of business, 31 July 1996.











## PhoneAway™ at the Olympics

Australian Olympians will carry one important piece of luggage when they head off to Atlanta. As part of Telstra's sponsorship of Australian Olympic teams, we are giving each athlete and official a \$150 PhoneAway card to make calling home easy while they are abroad.

This is the first special release of PhoneAway and the colourful design commemorates 100 years of modern Olympic games.

2,000 cards have been produced with an opportunity for collectors to purchase 560 from June. (A limit of 3 cards per collector. If needed, this amount will be re-evaluated and readjusted if over subscribed). There is no ballot with these cards, but will be sold on a first come, first serve basis so get in early for this piece of history!

Regular PhoneAway cards will be sold to athletes and officials in Atlanta to ensure they can keep in touch throughout the duration of the games.

The first PhoneAway series featuring gorgeous Australian landscapes are available now through the Telstra **Phonecard** Collectors Service.

Also watch out for the second special PhoneAway series, which will feature beautiful Australian seascapes. This is due for release in August. Keep reading for updates.
