A Day In The Life Of The Bulletin

We have received many enquiries from you, our valued collectors, regarding the production of the *Bulletin*.

The production of the *Bulletin* begins two months before its final distribution. Distribution commences after every Standing Order fulfilment and each time one issue of the *Bulletin* goes out, the next begins production.

The process is like any other publication...information is gathered, a draft is written and is then reviewed for accuracy.

At this stage information concerning new releases is not always up to date or available.

Advertising or Custom Phonecards [those where a client is involved] are produced on a very tight schedule, meaning that changes to the cards can often occur along the way. The client, designer(s) or Telstra may agree to change elements of the card design, quantity, denomination or production details at any time.

By the printing stage of the *Bulletin*, information concerning all Phonecards *is* as accurate as possible at that time. However, it is not uncommon that card details change after the *Bulletin* is produced.

Unfortunately late changes cannot be included due to our requirements to begin distribution of the *Bulletin* after the Standing Order run.

We regret that information may change, however our goal remains to provide collectors with up to date information about new Phonecard releases. Advising you of these changes is part of that process.

In future, corrections to the *Bulletin* will feature in the regular update of the 0055 info line under the second section.






