AUSTRALIAN PHONECARD FAIR - SYDNEY

A major International Phonecard Fair will be held in Sydney on 4 and 5 November. Staff from the **Phonecard** Collector Service will be present on both days selling all available cards and Limited Edition folders, and are looking forward to meeting collectors and answering any questions. The Fair will be held at the Holiday Inn Menzies, 14 Carrington Street above Wynyard Station.

CARDEX AWARDS - COCKIE WINS

One of Australia's favourite **Phonecards** has won an international telephone card design Award. The much loved 5th Birthday Cockie card won the prestigious "Overall Best Card" category at the CardEx 95 Design Awards. The Award was announced in Maastricht, the Netherlands, at CardEx 95, a major international telephone card convention.

This year the competition attracted hundreds of entries from every major card issuing country in the world.

The CardEx Awards aims to highlight and publicly recognise the best achievements in international card design. The Best Overall Card Award, won by Telstra, is granted to the company which has issued the most attractive, beautiful or striking of those entered.

The Cockie card, available in this issue of the Bulletin, will shortly be withdrawn from sale.

WALTZING MATILDA PORTFOLIO

The Waltzing Matilda Portfolio produced earlier this year to celebrate the centenary of "Banjo" Peterson's famous ballad, Waltzing Matilda was a sell out.

The Portfolios contained the new \$10 polymer note and a specially produced \$10 **Phonecard** with matching serial numbers. There were 5,000 produced in all - 1,000 Premium Portfolios and 4,000 Deluxe Portfolios.

A printing error occurred when the Portfolios were being numbered. The Premium Portfolios were numbered from 0001 of 1000 to 1000 of 1000. Instead of starting at 0001 of 4000 for the Deluxe Portfolios, the numbers ran-on after after the Premium Portfolios. Hence there are 1000 Deluxe Portfolios produced that are numbered from 4001 of 4000 to 5000 of 4000.

Telstra, Note Printing Australia and Sprintpak (the company responsible for producing the Portfolios) would like to stress that there were NO MORE than 1000 Premium Portfolios and NO MORE than 4000 Deluxe Portfolios produced in total. Telstra and Note Printing Australia each received 500 Premium and 2,000 Deluxe Portfolios. Telstra's allocation was distributed via a ballot system, which was well over-subscribed for both issues.

The recently conducted PCS survey showed overwhelmingly that this joint project was popular with collectors, and the PCS will consider upcoming opportunities to produce this sort of product in the future.

NEW RELEASES

OFFICIAL ISSUES

In this issue of the *Bulletin*, one new Official Issue (individual cards) is available for sale, and two Limited Edition folders.

The individual cards in the Emergency Management series were made available to collectors in the last issue of the *Bulletin*, and this issue sees the release of the Limited Edition folder for this series. The folder contains the \$5, \$10 and \$20 cards and is available for sale at \$46.50. There will be 6,000 folders produced. This Phonecard series aims to increase awareness about the enormous loss of life and property damage resulting from natural disasters.

The Christmas 1995 issue will be released through the shops during November and December and is available for sale in this issue of the *Bulletin*. The series contains a \$5, \$10 and \$20 card and the Limited Edition folder costs \$46.50. There will be 6,000 folders produced. It is the first Christmas issue to feature photographs, and the images depict Australia's unique festive season and Christmas spirit.

ADVERTISING CARDS

A series of eight Advertising cards is being released to commemorate the 75th Anniversary of Qantas. The cards feature various aircraft from the Avro 504 right through to the striking images of the Wunala Dreaming jumbo. The series includes five \$5 cards, two \$10 cards and one \$20 card and is available for sale in this issue of the *Bulletin*. The cards will be released through the shops in November.

Also available in this issue of the *Bulletin* are three new \$5 Advertising cards for AUSTEL promoting the new eight digit telephone numbers in certain areas. There were 107,000 cards released throughout NSW from the beginning of September to promote the new numbers in Sydney and 50,000 released in Brisbane throughout October and November to promote the new numbers there. Also in October and November, 250,000 will be released nationally promoting the new Melbourne numbers.

To commemorate Telstra's attendance at international telephone card Fairs, two \$5 Advertising cards were produced. Both cards carry the work of internationally acclaimed Australian artist Di Skelly Heron. The card produced for Phonecards Exhibition Singapore 95 features the Sulphur Crested Cockatoo and the Red Tailed Black Cockatoo features on the card produced for CardEx 95 in Maastricht.

There were 40,000 of each design produced - 10,000 packaged cards were available at the Fairs, 20,000 will be released through the shops in October and 10,000 are available for sale through this issue of *Bulletin*.

Telstra is proud to be the principal sponsor of the China Beijing Opera Troupe, which is appearing at the Sydney Opera House on 23 October and at the Victorian Arts Centre in Melbourne on 27 October. To commemorate the only two Australian performances Telstra has released a series of four **Phonecards**: two \$5 cards, one \$10 and one \$20 card. The cards will be released through the shops in Sydney and Melbourne only, in October and are available for sale in this issue of the *Bulletin*.

UPCOMING ISSUES

In December, the annual Australia Day card will be released. The \$5 card will be sold in the shops throughout December and January, and will be available to collectors in the December issue of the *Bulletin*.

The next issue released after the Australia Day issue will be a series of three cards - \$5, \$10, \$20 - featuring various modes of transport: ferries/river cats, buses and trains. The series will be released through the shops at the end of January. The individual cards in this series will be available nationally in January for collectors in the December issue of the *Bulletin*.

CORRECTIONS

In issue No 5 of the *Bulletin*, it was stated that batch no. 748 contained a \$5 Custom card. This batch was originally a composite made up of Custom card designs and the \$5 and \$10 Book Muncher.

The custom cards were withdrawn from production at a late stage, so batch 748 contains 10,500 each of the \$5 and \$10 Book Muncher cards.

NEW CARD PRODUCT

For Christmas 1995, Telstra has launched an original gift idea - specially designed greetings cards with matching **Phonecards**.

The specially commissioned images featured on the cards were taken by Sydney photographer Michael Scott Lees and reflect Australia's own unique Christmas spirit. There are three different

Phonecard designs and denominations which are included in the specially packaged gift card. These designs are exclusive to the gift card/**Phonecard** pack and do not appear on the Official Issue Christmas **Phonecards** which will be released through the shops.

The \$5 **Phonecard** and matching gift card features Santa in the Bush, the \$10 **Phonecard** and matching gift card features the all Australian kelpie and the \$20 **Phonecard** and matching gift card features tea and Christmas cake at a bush table.

The **Phonecard** carries the new "G" code (see next story) and will not be available through Telstra. They are available from mid-late October through selected retail outlets. For your nearest stockist, ring 1800 024 252.

The Christmas 1995 issue is the first in what will be regular releases of the **Phonecard** gift pack - the ideal gift for family and friends around the country. Watch out for more **Phonecard** gift ideas on Valentine's Day, Mother's Day, birthdays - any occasion you want to show you care. See page 15 for illustration.

NEW CARD CODES

Phonecard has experienced the highest penetration of any telecommunications product after the home phone. It is anticipated that some time early in 1996 Telstra will sell its 50 millionth **Phonecard**. With this sort of phenomenal growth, two new card codes have been developed as **Phonecard** usage continues to expand. The new codes are:

G GIFT CARDS

This category encompasses cards that are produced for inclusion within a gift card, and are not available for sale individually. They will be produced by Telstra and will be available for sale through selected retail outlets. They will not be available for sale through Telstra.

P PROMOTIONAL

Promotional cards may be produced by companies to:

- promote their company's products and services
- give away to their customers and clients
- sell through their own outlets as advertising
- commemorate special events
- act as a fundraiser for charities

The **Phonecard** Collector Service reserves the right to on-print up to an additional 10,000 cards of any design in the promotional category for sale to collectors. This will only occur if the PCS perceives there will be a demand for a certain design.

The Promotional category is the only category in which \$2 cards will be produced. The words "complimentary card" will be printed on the **Phonecard** and these cards cannot be sold by the commissioning company. These cards will not be available for sale through Telstra.

These two codes have been added to the already existing codes.

N NATIONAL

National Issue (or Official Issue) cards are those cards which carry images selected by Telstra's **Phonecard** Design Committee and are produced for ongoing use in payphones.

Official Issue cards are generally commemorative, such as Australia Day, Christmas and the Olympics, decorative, such as the Australian Landscape issues, or thematic, such as Dinosaurs and Endangered Species.

National, or Official Issue, cards are released Australia wide through Telstra's official Phonecard retail network - newsagents, supermarkets, service stations etc.

L LIMITED EDITION

Limited Edition cards carry the same image on the front of the card as National or Official Issue cards. The back of the card has been changed to distinguish it from the regular National issues. One of the barcodes on back of the card has been removed, and instead it carries a description of the card series.

These cards are only available packaged in Limited Edition folders and are produced in limited quantities, between 5,000 - 10,000.

A ADVERTISING

Advertising cards carry images designed to promote or advertise companies and their products or services. Telstra sponsorships are also promoted through Advertising cards.

At least 50 per cent of Advertising cards must be released through Telstra's national official **Phonecard** agent network. The remaining 50 per cent may be taken by the advertiser, if they so desire, for their own promotional purposes.

I INTERNATIONAL

International cards are produced by Telstra but are not encoded for use in Australian payphones. Whilst they carry Telstra branding, they are encoded with the currency denomination of the country in which Telstra has installed the payphone system, either on a temporary or permanent basis. Countries for which international cards have been produced include Cambodia, Vietnam, and Kazakhstan.

S SPECIAL

Cards will be issued in this category once or twice a year for special or one-off events that do not fit appropriately into any of the existing categories. Unlike Custom cards, Special Issue cards will be available for sale to collectors through the mail order service.

C CUSTOM

These are essentially private issue advertising cards for specific promotional purposes. They can be produced in much smaller print runs than general Advertising cards and are not available for sale through Telstra.

The Custom card category has had new restrictions placed upon it which will serve to control the number of cards being issued and their impact upon the collectors market. There will be a restriction of 24 designs issued per year under this category.

T TERRITORY

With Christmas Island now receiving National, Official Issue Australia cards, there will no longer be cards issued in the Territory category.
