

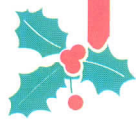

EDITORIAL

A magazine which commenced as a 'hobby' enters its second year of production with this, the November 1994, issue. It has grown from 32 and 36 pages (with no colour) to 48 pages including 16 in full colour and many with spot colour.

The 'hobby' activity is well and truly over and serious thought and planning continuous in relation to the direction the magazine now takes.

Associated with the growth of the magazine, the growth in the 'phonocard scene' continues. Following the sharp increase in the production of phonocards, particularly of Custom cards, two weeks ago I planned to increase the magazine's content to 48 pages (plus cover), an increase of 8 pages on the previous highest monthly total. A week ago, after I had committed myself to this month's format, it was evident that even this substantial increase in pages was insufficient. Hence, again a suppliment.

New Custom card manufacturers are introduced in this magazine, together with the arrival of a new payphone service (**Cardphone Australia**) and associated phonocards - which look magnificent - but then I did 'back' both Lets Elope and Subzero.

Dealers continue to advertise and there is no apparent 'slackening' of interest in the ever expanding field of phonocard collecting. One particular advert fascinated me - that on page 38 of the magazine - for the first time used **Custom cards** are being advertised in quantity - some with very small print runs!

Computerised phonocard recording and information systems also continue to be developed, areas which will assist the collector to readily access information as to rapidly expanding collections.

In relation to the increase in demand for space (and my time) I have outlined opposite, the **Deadlines** for receipt of material for the **December and January issues**. These Deadlines will be updated each issue for the forthcoming two months.

With the increase in pages (which will be maintained and in fact further added to) comes commensurate costs in relation to production and (in particular) postage. As such, it has become necessary to increase the cover price of the magazine as well as upgrade subscription rates.

In relation to subscribers, I have set a policy in relation to the 'mail out' of magazines. As from this issue, **magazines will be mailed the first Friday of each month**, (except for January - Christmas break) firstly to WA, NT, Tasmania, Nth. Qld. and 'outback' SA. Time permitting, other states will be mailed on the Friday. The balance of the magazines will be posted on the **following (first Monday) of each month**.

The response to the \$2.00 Complimentary card has been excellent to date, with a steady stream of new subscribers as well as nearly all initial subscribers renewing their subscriptions which have now commenced to become due. Telecom Australia advises that the cards themselves will be available around the 14th of November and a 'mail out' will commence then or else (if received later), with the December issue of the magazine.

In closing, note the suppliment for the official Telecom statistics in relation to the number of packs destroyed and as a consequence; the number remaining - a couple of supprises!

NSW NATIONAL PARKS AND WILDLIFE

"TAKE A SLICE OF THE ACTION"

The Hon. Chris Hartcher MP, Minister for the Environment, will launch the first-ever NSW National Parks and Wildlife Service (NPWS) collectable Telecom Phonecard series on 7 November, at the historic site of Fort Denison - which also features on one of the phonecards in the collection.

The limited edition series is the largest collectable series issued in Australia, containing 10,000 sets of 15 x \$2.00 phonecards. The Collection depicts scenes of NSW national parks, wildlife, historic sites, helicopter water bombing, bushfire fighting - to name a few - all illustrated by world-acclaimed airbrush artist and illustrator, Gregory Bridges.

The series was issued by the NPWS in conjunction with Worldwide Collectables Pty Ltd.

Worldwide Collectables Director, John Bushell, said that the Collection is one of the most exciting Custom card collections to be issued in Australia, promoting our tourism, our natural heritage and, sound "green" principles.

"Apart from the splendour of the illustrations, all depicting themes relating to the work and environment of the NPWS, a portion of the sales proceeds will be used by the NPWS towards the preservation of our national parks, wildlife and heritage".

This world view will add significant value to the Collection".

The cards are produced from PET material (recycled plastic bottle containers), which according to Mr. Bushell, is all part of the "green appeal" which will be appreciated by the ecologically-minded collector. As one USA publisher put it, "we are turning trash into art pieces".

There are several unique features of the release of this Collection which is proving to be highly attractive to the astute collector.

Firstly, this is the highest value for money Collection set yet released in Australia. It offers fifteen \$2.00 Telecom Australia Phonecards at a very competitive price; each a stunning art piece and all set in a custom designed commemorative album.

Secondly, for the first time, collectors have the option to "lock in" on specific serial number future releases.

Thirdly, purchase of the set includes \$35.00 worth of free privileges through the Foundation for National Parks and Wildlife.

There are two sets in this limited edition collection. The standard set can now be obtained for \$120.00 and the low number edition (900 originally available from 101 - 1,000) for \$200.00. THE GRAPEVINE

by Insider

This month's article is about the different individuals involved in our hobby. They can be described as:-

(a) Collectors (b) Dealers (c) Investors (d) Speculators (e) Manufacturers

Each of the above is necessary for the hobby to develop and to grow!

The **collector** creates the basic demand for phonecards and needs to obtain past issues at convenient locations. Collectors also may not have the time to research or to keep up to date with the latest developments. They also need to be able to dispose of swaps and other items as required at some time or other. Methods of disposal include adverts in the Australasian Phonecard Monthly and direct selling to dealers.

Dealers provide the mechanism whereby a market is created by buying and selling the phonecards. Supply and demand regulate price. Contrary to some beliefs, dealers only have a limited role in determining prices. The publishing of dealer prices has the effect of setting a benchmark but if this benchmark is too far out, then supply/demand take over. If the price is set too high others undercut this price to drive the level down. If the price is too low, dealers run down their supplies.

Investors (and this includes nearly everyone in one form or another) may augment their collection with "extra" purchases of quality cards with an eye on a future return. I define the investor as, primarily, a collector with extra funds with which they hope to receive a return at some time in the future. They usually have a long term view to their investments which is the safest method of investing in markets that fluctuate over time.

Speculators in the main are looking for more short term gains and can often have a negative effect on the market as they are usually the ones who bulk purchase. Without the speculators bulk investments though, the future supplies for new collectors would be very limited. Of course, the existing collector likes to see something that they bought go up in price but without future stocks, new collectors would not be able to join the hobby and so the growth of collector numbers would be limited. The disadvantage of the speculator is that they often have no interest in collecting and may attempt to manipulate the market by controlling supplies. Speculators also suffer from the "jitters" which can result in them "dropping the bundle" at some point!! If they "drop" or "off-load" their bulk purchase, it will obviously effect the market and prices.

Manufacturers need to have a responsible issuing policy to give reasonable stability to the hobby. To date Telecom Australia have been passing in this area. Telecom enable everyone to obtain attractive new releases easily and conveniently and promote the hobby effectively (well that is the theory at least!). Private issuers often come up with far more interesting designs than Telecom do and so add interest to the collection but the downside is that an avenue is created for another 'breed' of speculators.

The problem created between the above groups is often through ignorance of the other's requirements or situation. Some undersatanding of each groups place in the overall scheme of things will hopefully lead to more satisfaction in general between all involved.

Some pluses and minuses for the above groups are as follows:-

The collector often wants the dealer to supply his/her missing cards at reasonable (or less) prices and then expects the dealers to buy all his/her 2,000 spare \$5 Opera House Generics at 10%!! Dealers have to pay for their stock and collectors often want "retail" or "list" price for their unwanted cards without appreciating that the dealer needs to make a living if they are to provide the collector with the service they require! At present, dealers are struggling under the onslaught of cash flow problems generated by the increased number of new cards on the market. This is hard for collectors to understand when the dealer states that they are not buying as much this month from collectors because of cash flow demands. Until the situation stabilises, do not expect to get top prices from dealers. This reduced buying from dealers is being misinterpreted by some collectors as the market falling away. New collectors are still coming in to the hobby at a steady rate and so the future is looking good for all except those who want to sell when demand is low or those who want to buy when supply is low!!

Next month we will see a revision of dealers prices due to the release of Telecom's "destruction" list of early packs. Looking back at dealer prices over the last three months and knowing what I could actually obtain items for through that period, which was often much less than certain advertised prices, I expect some prices to be revised downwards in relation to the "high prices". This does not mean that prices have dropped, just that some advertised prices were bordering on the "rip-off" levels!

THEMATIC - Sailing

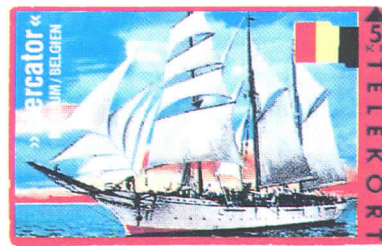
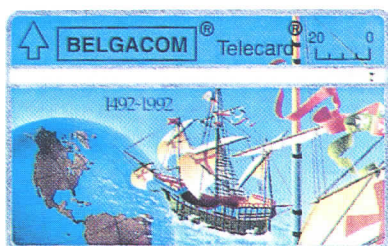
From INTERCARDS by Peter Granfield

Continuing in our series on thematic collecting, this month we will take a look at some of the cards that have been issued on the theme of sailing. Sailing could come under the general theme of "Transport", which is one of the largest and most popular. However, in limiting this article to sailing, we have taken out all the other forms of shipping such as luxury cruisers, cargo ships, fishing boats, barges and canal boats, all of which have appeared on phonecards. You will see from the cards shown that even sailing could be broken down to more restricted themes such as tall ships, yachts or sailboards. Whatever the individuals choice, it is important in all areas of collecting, including thematic, to set the parameters of what you wish to collect so that the goal is an achievable one, especially with personal financial limitations in mind. If this is not done from the outset, you will lose heart and pursue something else. It is always better to start with a very narrow theme and later expand.

Antigua & Barbuda - In May 1993, these Islands issued a set of 5 cards for "Sailing Week". The values were EC\$10, 20, 40, 54 and 60; the latter two being scarce with only 5,000 issued. Anguilla, Bahamas, Barbados, St. Lucia and St. Vincent & the Grenadines are other Caribbean Islands that have issued cards on this theme.

Belgium - Belgium was one of a number of countries that issued a card in 1992 to commemorate the Christopher Columbus Sesquicentennial.

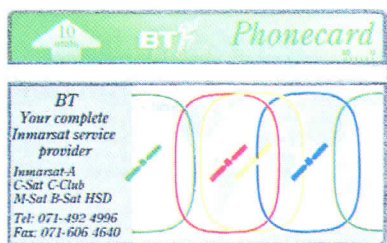
Denmark - Possibly the most attractive of all the sets issued on this theme, is the set of 12 issued by Denmark. The set was released in stages, commencing in July 1993 and finishing in January 1994. There were 3,500 of the earlier issues and only 2,500 of the later issues.



Great Britain - A slight variation on the theme in that this card does not actually show a yacht. British Telecom recently issued this card in recognition of the INMARSAT service, a satellite navigation system used by international shipping to locate their exact position from anywhere in the world. A vital instrument to the 'round the world' sailors.

Great Britain - We illustrate this card because we were out of stock of the New Zealand card for the same event; the 'Whitbread Round the World Yacht Race'. The attractive NZ set of 4 join together as a collage to create a full map of the world with the course illustrated on the cards. NZ issued 2,500 of the sets in a collector pack. Both loose cards and collector packs have been very popular and have risen in price quite considerably.

Japan - Our selection this month is the beautiful 'Kaiwomaru' at sunset. Japan has issued quite a number of 'Tall Ships' on phonecards as well as other cards depicting the many forms of sailing.



Jersey - This card was issued for the 1993 European Championships of the Hobie Cat 16'. Catamaran racing is one of the most popular and affordable forms of sailing and the Hobies are a recognised worldwide class.

Korea - This card from Korea takes up the 'Sailboarding' stream of this theme. Many other countries have also issued cards with sailboards; known examples being Barbados, Denmark, Great Britain, Hawaii and Hungary.

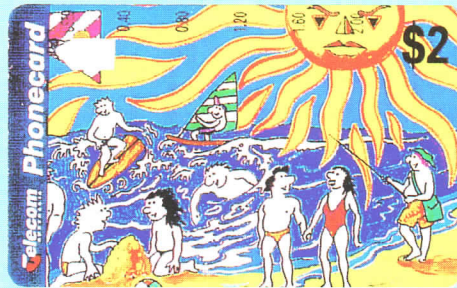
New Zealand - This card issued in January 1994, is a classic dual theme card which is an excellent addition to the sailing theme. The picture illustrated the extreme opposite end of the sailing scale to that of the 'Whitbread' racing cards.

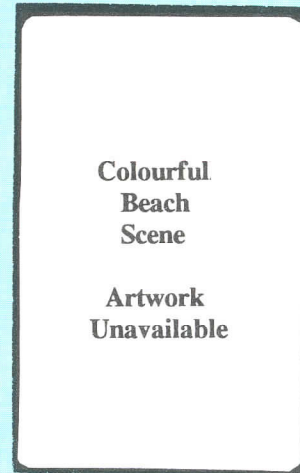

THE ITALIAN SCENE

Beng a collector of overseas phonecards, I was always intrigued how my name was found by so many Italian collectors writing to me and offering to exchange cards with me. They always enclosed the standard generic Italian cards and you were then obliged to send back some Australian cards or return their cards and say, "no thanks".



I had planned to visit Europe on a holiday in their summer and as I wrote down the places I always wanted to see, I also included on the list, to observe the Italian Payphone System.

We travelled around Europe by train and our first stop in Italy was the beautiful city of Florence. On the main railway station there were two clusters of eight telephone boxes and individual boxes around the walls. It was a golden opportunity, because almost everyone who gets off the train rushes straight to the payphones to make a call using a phonecard. All the cubicles had a lockable orange box to dispose of all the used phonecards so, on first impressions, I did not think much of my chances.

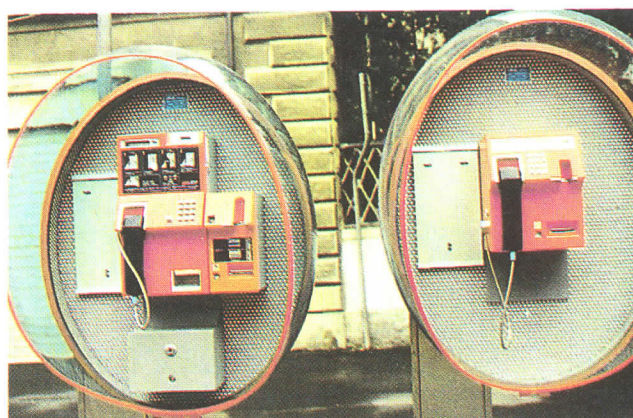
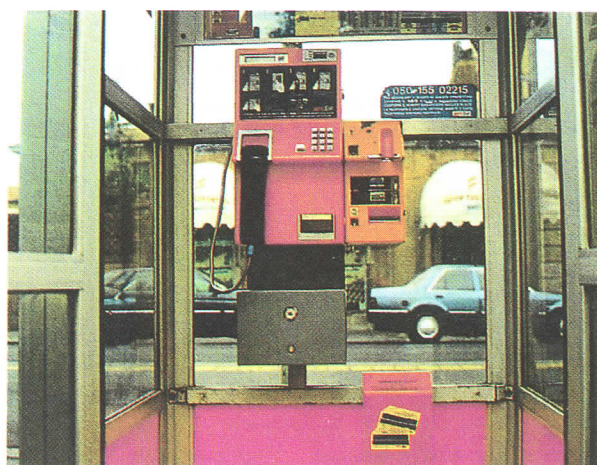
There had to be a collector somewhere, searching for cards. I wasn't waiting for very long, when a tall bearded man with a money belt started the routine that I had performed myself in Australia. He looked on the top of the telephone, on the floor and to my surprise, his hand flicked open the box that holds the used cards. It was great to watch a professional. The cards he swept up with his hand were filed away in the front of the money belt.

I'd got the idea! It was my turn now. I visited those boxes on the station about three times a day and collected a wonderful amount of 30 cards. The only problem was, that 27 of them were the same generic type card! Now I understood why it was so hard to build a collection of different Italian cards.

On the third day, in the morning, I started my routine only to find that the disposal boxes had been locked by a technician. That 'was it' I thought! Later in the afternoon, I went back to check them

out again. To my surprise, the doors were unlocked. Some wonderful collector must have had a key and left them unlocked so that we could all have a turn. The main city streets have the bright orange payphone boxes in pairs about 100 metres apart and are located on both sides of the footpath. They are very easy to see from a distance. The designs of the telephones and cubicles are modern and streamlined, however, there are always used cards littering the ground waiting for the collector to pick up and send to other collectors in Australia!

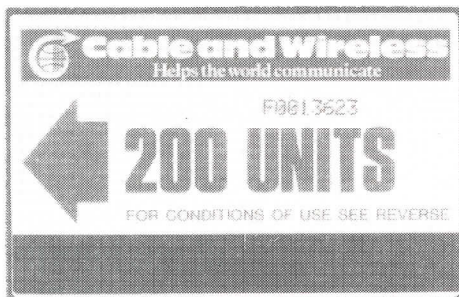
FOCUS ON FARAWAY PLACES

This Month: **FALKLAND ISLANDS**
by Cyril Fox

The Falkland Islands are situated in the South Atlantic, due East of the Strait of Magellan, at the southern end of the continent of South America. There are approximately 200 islands in the group - the main islands being West Falkland and East Falkland, divided from each other by the narrow Falkland Sound. The capital is Stanley.

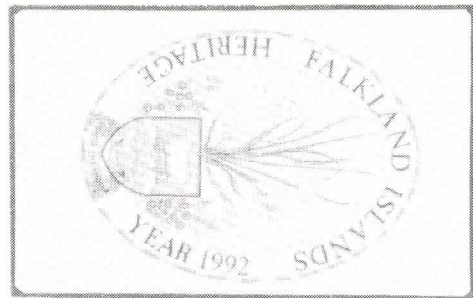
The English navigator, John Davis, is believed to have been the first European to sight the islands, in 1592. The first settlement was in 1764 on East Falkland by a group of French colonists; in 1765 a British settlement was established on West Falkland. The British left the islands in 1774 and they came under Spanish rule until 1820, when Argentina claimed sovereignty of the group. In 1833 Britain took control of the Falklands; an "imperialist" act which gave rise to the sovereignty dispute which continues to this day between Britain and Argentina. Telephone cards were introduced in 1985 by Cable & Wireless. The first issue comprised three values of magnetic card supplied by Autelca:-

50 units Green value on white/blue background
100 units Pale blue on white/blue background
200 units Red value on white/blue background



The 50 unit and 100 unit cards are still common today, while the 200 unit card is very scarce (only 20,000 were issued).

A special 50 units card with a floral design on a pale yellow background was issued in 1992 for the Falkland Islands Heritage Year.



In 1993 there was a shortage of 50 unit cards, so an unknown number of 100 unit cards were devalued to 50 units. This was done by simply crossing out the "100" with 2 or 3 strokes of a pen. There is no way of telling whether the pen devaluation is authentic - collectors should be cautious not to pay a high price for an allegedly devalued card.

In 1993, Cable & Wireless changed to using magnetic cards by GPT (similar in appearance to New Zealand cards). A new issue of three values picturing penguins replaced the previous bland Autelca cards.

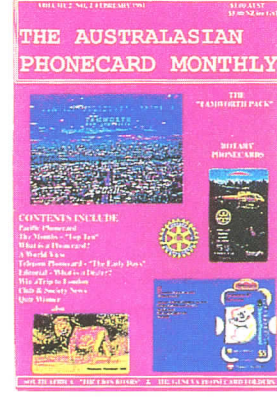

ADDENDUM TO

VOLUME 2. ISSUE NO. 11, NOVEMBER 1994

Due to the large amount of material received late in October, together with the release of Telecom Australia's figures in relation to the number of destroyed "official Telecom Collector Packs" (1st of Nov), to keep you informed, a supplement has been added to the November issue.

TELECOM'S COLLECTOR PACK STATISTICS

Outlined below are the figures in relation to the number of Collector Packs destroyed by Telecom and as a consequence, the number remaining. Included to the right, are the estimates as provided by the two winners of the "guessing competition" as outlined in the *Grapevine* column of the last issue of APM.

The winners in the two categories were Albert Tay from Wantirna, Victoria and Wishart Phonocards from Mt. Gravatt, Queensland. Each winner will receive 5 of the forthcoming \$2.00 Complimentary Phonocards, as being printed by Telecom for this magazine. As Mr Tay's guess "beat" that of the winning dealer, he wins a further 5 Phonocards. His guess, you will agree, was extremely close - being only 466 off the correct total. The next best collector's entry was that of Rinaldo Avola of Ascot Vale, Victoria, whose estimate was 691 out (87,725).

It was interesting to note that nearly every entry (67 received) exceeded the figure of 5,000 for the Australia Day 1992 Packs, ie., they did not seem to realise that only 5,000 of these packs were produced!

Most of the above (high) figures in relation to 'packs destroyed' were "tipped" by dealers, collectors and speculators, some months ago. I refer of course to the South Australia, Queensland, Victoria, Red Cross and Olympic packs. One or two surprises were revealed however, eg., the high number of ACT packs destroyed, particularly when taken in context with other state packs released just before and just after - it was a \$34 face value pack though, which was a high price at 'the time'. Another surprise was the small number of \$5 Generics destroyed - 'most' tipped that the figure would be much higher, due mainly to the blandness of the card and pack - it was cheap to buy however. The number of Geelong packs destroyed was also much lower than thought - as a first issue however, it was obviously popular. The number of Olympic packs destroyed was high, but then it was an expensive pack to buy, particularly at a time when packs were not in 'vogue', nor was the collector market great in number.

Collectors, dealers, speculators and manufacturers, will have a 'good time' analysing the above figures (not so good if you are holding stock purchased above what will become market value). Prices for packs will now stabilise with some items increasing in value and some decreasing. At last, everyone has some tangible figures to relate to.

Whilst care has to be taken - the above packs were produced some years ago when the collector base was small - to me, a number of thoughts are reinforced; firstly, there are still not 10,000 individual collectors of packs in Australia (be they Telecom or other) - the 'buy out' of recent Telecom packs was mainly as a result of speculators; secondly, the price to be paid for a pack is a key decider in its purchase; eg., whilst 15,000 of the 500th Grand Prix pack were made, it was inexpensive to buy (had a good theme and a wide market); thirdly, the theme being espoused is important as is the design of the card/s itself and fourthly, obviously the print number is a key, eg Generic and Australia Day 92 packs, whilst both were hardly 'eye catchers', only had pack numbers of 6,000 and 5,000 respectively, thereby making them attractive.

Any thoughts and comments on the above figures, would be welcomed from readers - Editor.

NEW ZEALAND NEWS UPDATE

MARKET NEWS

Reports are that the market for collector packs has rebounded slightly, with prices increasing on some packs. Some dealers are once again buying recent issue packs at 20% - 30% over issue price, eg., AdPack 6 has just come out at NZ\$160.00 and dealers have been paying \$200-\$210 for it.

It seems that the 'dumping' of packs by speculators may have eased and with their retreat, the market is readjusting and in fact gradually improving in regards to some items, ie., trying to return to the 'pre craze' days of June and July, although many packs still remain well below prices as they then were.

As indicated in the September issue of the APM, Telecom New Zealand has recently issued the first edition of their new, bi-monthly PhoneCard collector magazine, the "Telecom Collector PhoneCard News". (*Collectors can obtain free copies of this newsletter by writing to Nathan Mercer, PO Box 3007, Christchurch, New Zealand.*)

Telecom NZ has recently announced a world-wide tender for the supply of new Payphones, presumably smart cards. Details are still 'sketchy' at this stage - more information will be provided next month.

Cardnet Services are producing a set of four combination chip and magnetic cards during November. They will work in normal Payphones and can also be used to buy food, petrol, books, etc. Again, more details next month.

TELECOM REGIONAL PHONECARD AUCTIONS

Following on from the success of the inaugural Telecom PhoneCard Auction in Auckland in June, Telecom is staging 3 Regional Auctions: Christchurch, Wellington and Auckland (the latter two in November). Telecom has produced a special \$2 Regional Auction card in a folder. Only 1,000 "Butterfly" cards have been produced. They are overprinted on \$2 Standard Issue Satellite cards. 250 of each card are being given out at each auction to all successful bids. 50 are also being placed in each auction for sale. There will be no additional cards for dealers or for collector packs.

At the Regional Auction in Christchurch (October 29) some of the "more notable prices" realised were:-

RECENT ISSUES

GENERAL ISSUES

1994 International Year of the Family - This set of four PhoneCards has been produced to commemorate 1994 as the International Year of the Family. The four cards in the series are: \$5 Reaching Families (120,000), \$5 Home, Family and the Community (120,000), \$10 Families and Fun (80,000) \$20 Families Valuing Learning (40,000). There have been 4,000 Collector Packs produced, all these cards have "Collectors Issue 1994" printed on the reverse. The pack also comes with the 1994 AGM card in a folder. The issue price is NZ\$85.

ADCARDS

'Spot' in Amsterdam was produced for the Cardex '94 International phonecard exhibition held in Amsterdam. The card depicts the popular Telecom Mascot 'Spot', standing among the tulip fields of Holland. The loose cards were on sale in Amsterdam together with a special Fair Souvenir Pack known as a PASSPORT. The Passport contains a 'Spot' mint set and the Amsterdam 'Spot' card.

The Hotel Association of NZ has used the advertising medium of an AdCard to increase community awareness of drink driving. The card (produced in August) advises the maximum legal limits (in NZ) of the amount of alcohol men and women can consume while still being allowed to drive. When you are over the limit, you can use the card to phone for alternative transport.

The Anne Geddes Classic Collection has been commissioned by Prestige Marketing Ltd. This set of four cards feature captivating studies of children by award winning photographer Anne Geddes.

The Totalisator Agency Board commissioned this card (in September) which features the New Zealand horse 'Kiwi' which won the 1983 Melbourne Cup. The TAB will be giving the majority of the cards to new account holders as an incentive to join their phone betting service.

The Christchurch Casino produced a card in September to commemorate the opening of New Zealand's first casino. The card itself is a stylised Ace of Hearts and is only one of a few \$50 AdCards produced by Telecom to date. There have been 2,000 of each card placed in a limited edition folder. Included in each folder is an opening edition casino chip of which only 3,000 have been produced. Three further packs will be produced for the casino for each anniversary, the next featuring the Ace of Spades and so on.

Farmers Trading Company was formed in 1909 as a mail order business, catering to the needs of New Zealand Farmers. In its 85th year of business two cards have been commissioned to tie in with a 'scratch and win' promotion. The cards are being sold through all Farmers outlets in New Zealand.

Watercare Services Ltd has produced a PhoneCard to promote the ongoing need for water conservation in the Auckland area. It gives five usefull hints for conserving water.

NEW DEALER CARDS

Reflections of China - This set of five cards was produced by Pacific Coin Co Ltd. The cards depict some of the well known images of China - the Great Wall of China, the Giant Panda, the Buried Army of Xian and the two popular Chinese symbols - the Double Happy and the "88". There are only 1,000 loose sets.

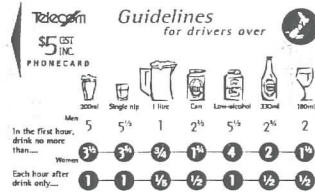
Lion King - This card commissioned by Event Masters, celebrates the release of this year's most stunning and memorable full feature film, Walt Disney's "The Lion King". A total of 4,000 presentation folders have been produced. The folder contains the card as well as Elton John's Compact Disc soundtrack of the movie. The folders have been sold through a nationwide television campaign and through a major nationwide record chain.

Vintage Card Club - This card was produced by the Canterbury Vintage Car Club to commemorate the swap meet and display. The card depicts a Bently, a Model A Ford, an Essex and a Bugatti. The annual two day event attracts 30,000 spectators from around the world. 4,000 cards have been produced and put into a special presentation folder with two other special cardboard collector cards.

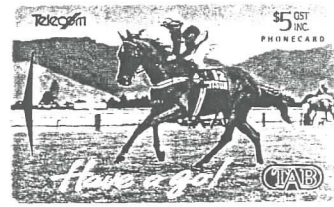

TELECOM AUSTRALIA - UPCOMING PHONECARD INFORMATION

Telecom will be producing a Limited Edition folder for the Christmas issue. The set will consist of three cards, a \$5, a \$10 and a \$20. It is expected that this issue will be even more highly sought after than ever, so the print run has been increased to 9,500 to cater for this demand.

The cards and folder will carry bright, collage style designs featuring Australiana Christmas themes and also marking the United Nations International Year of the Family. Distribution will commence in November with the Limited Edition sets being available with the November issue of the catalogue. The sets will retail for \$45.50.

In conjunction with the Christmas additions, Telecom is also launching a commercial Greetings card, which is being manufactured by John Sands and will only be available through retail outlets. The Greetings card will be in the same style as the Phonocard and the Limited Edition folder. It will have provision for the inclusion of a Christmas Phonocard, to be purchased separately.

The individual cards will be available through the normal outlets during February and March. The Limited Edition folder will be available with the January catalogue for \$45.50.

The popular Character "Bookmuncher" is to have an additional number of cards produced. There will be a \$10 and a \$20 Phonocard to compliment the existing \$5 card. They are due for release towards the end of the year.

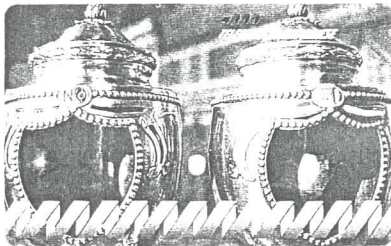
