

From the publisher

Phonecard values

UR single most popular editorial feature in Phonecard Collector each month, based on reader feedback and letters to the editor, is the Market Report.

This feature values mint (unused) and used (both single-hole and multihole) Australian phonecards and is based on an average of leading

phonecard dealers' retail prices.

Several readers and callers have commented on the relationship between prices appearing in our Market Report and retail prices charged by dealers for the items listed. Some are higher and some are lower. This should not come as any surprise to the reader, given that it is assembled from a range of dealer pricelists.

Others, especially our younger readers, have suggested that there can be a great variation between the prices quoted in our Market Report and

those offered by dealers.

To understand this situation, collectors should consider that the dealer has to make a profit on every transaction. Usually, the margin between a dealer's selling and buying prices is much narrower for the higher priced

items (such as South Australia packs).

However, even this "rule of thumb" may not apply when the item is not in heavy demand. If an item is not heavily traded, its retail price may not vary much. Without heavy demand, even though a relatively high price may have become fixed, an item may command only a fraction of retail when offered to a dealer.

Cheaper used phonecards, though popular, are available in very large quantities and, between dealers, may be traded in bundles of hundreds or even thousands. Even though a dealer may sell such a card for between one and two dollars, this represents more of a handling charge than an

actual relationship to intrinsic value.

If the dealer has hundreds of a particular card in storage, he will be unwilling to add more to his stock unless it is readily saleable. Howeve, rather than declining to buy further stocks, he may offer a rock-bottom price, thinking that, at such a low level, he will not be buying a "lemon"

which will sit in stock and gather dust for years.

Consider for a moment, the plight of the phonecard dealer, who has paid a price, albeit a low one in some cases, for every phonecard in his vast stock. Many such cards will sit on his shelves for years. This ties up money and space. Heavy purchasing in the past may thus limit the dealer's cash flow and ability to purchase what is offered to him by collectors.

So, next time you are ready to condemn the business practices of a phonecard dealer, give a thought to the ramifications of trading in cards.

Technical Briefing

Smart cards: an introduction

HIP cards or "Smart Cards" as they are often called, provide a relatively new method of carrying monetary credit on a plastic card.

This credit may be used to purchase a range of services, or, in the case of phonecards, a particular service: that of using a prepaid credit to pay for phone calls made from a payphone.

A chip card contains an imbedded electronic circuit - "the chip". The functional complexity of this imbedded circuit determines the area of application of a chip card and the card cost.

The most complex chip provides a full computing function which is designed for financial transaction and other high security applications.

Chip cards suitable for phonecard applications lie at the lower end of the complexity scale. They are cards which have a pre-set monetary credit when purchased - a credit which is progressively reduced as the card is used to pay for calls through payphones. They are often referred-to as "token" cards.

This article explains chip technology as applied to phonecards and how the chip cards are used in a payphone environment. Card costs and payphone operator implementation philosophies are also addressed.

Phonecards with embedded chips

HIPS imbedded in phonecards are "memory only" chips. Figure 1 shows the internal

layout of a typical phonecard memory-only chip.

Two areas of memory

THERE are two areas of memory. The first memory area is programmed during card manufacture with data that may not be altered in any way.

This data includes the card number, card issuing authority ID and any other permanent data required for the application, such as face value of the card.


The second memory area contains a string of "units" which, during card manufacture, are all set to "available". These units (or "tokens") are progressively programmed through the chip reader as "not available" during or at the end of a call - thus establishing the remaining value of the card (the electronic equivalent of punching holes in a card).

Memory-only card chips are not re-programmable and when all "units" are used, the card must be replaced.

It is interesting to note that the remaining card value is stored only in the internal chip memory and may be read only when the card is inserted into a payphone.

Because there is no visible usage indication (by hole or mark) external on the card, new cards are often sold in sealed plastic bags.

Chip cards are virtually tamper proof. This is a real security "plus" for payphone operators who, worldwide, have been battling with increasing incidence of card fraud.

How are chip cards used?

HIP cards may only be used in payphones equipped with a chip card reader. The reader comprises a simple set of contact "fingers" which make contact with the chip contacts when the card is inserted.

When a card is inserted, the payphone electronics will read both memory locations and display the remaining card value.

As a call progresses or at the conclusion of a call, the available "units" in memory location #2 are reduced by the amount equal to the cost of the call. At the conclusion of a call it is usual to display the remaining value.

These readers are at once an advantage and a disadvantage to large payphone operators. The big advantage of chip card readers is their simplicity.

There are effectively no moving parts and compared with the most simple magnetic stripe reader, maintenance costs are dramatically reduced.

One big disadvantage to large payphone operators is the cost of conversion away from any other existing technology to re-equip thousands (or tens of thousands) of payphones to chip card operation.

Do chip phonecards look the same?

O. There are two positions where the chip may be placed on a phonecard. Refer to figure 2 (see page 4).

The international standard position is almost in the centre of the card towards the left-hand edge.

The alternate position, used in the French telecommunications network, is towards the upper left hand corner. This layout usually is identified as a "Telecarte" phonecard.

The chip functionality is the same for both card layouts. It is also interesting to note that some Telecom



authorities (eg, South Africa) print the card image on the smooth (nonchip) side, whilst most other issuing authorities print the card image on the chip side - often making a feature of the chip.


Chip contacts on the face of the card may be gold, silver or nickel plated to provide a continuing good electrical connection with the "fingers" in the chip reader. The contact shapes may vary slightly between chip manufacturers.

How much do chip cards cost?

HIP cards, like all electronic components, reflect a price which is very quantity-dependent. From a price of approximately \$7 per card (printed) for a quantity of 20,000 cards, the price drops dramatically to under \$1 for a quantity of over 500,000 cards.

Every (new) phonecard sold in Australia is subject to an Australian Government levy of 21% sales tax.

Major Telecom companies throughout the world have the requirements and resources to purchase chip cards in large enough quantities (the order of millions) to make the costs compatible with existing technologies - keeping in mind that one major advantage of chip technology is that remaining



value security is several orders of magnitude greater than is presently available using other technologies.

With the much higher costs for small quantities of chip cards compared with other technologies, the introduction of chip phonecards by small payphone operators could not be justified at the present time on phone usage margins alone.

Where are chip phonecards being used now?

HIP phonecards are being used extensively throughout Europe. Chip card technology

was introduced as a commercial reality in France. Phonecards utilising this new technology are now an integral part of the French telephone network and are being integrated into the payphone networks of other European countries.

These cards are now in use or on trial in a number of other countries including Isle of Man, South Africa, Ireland, the USA and New Zealand.

The chip phonecard is here to stay, but because of the entrenched technologies in a number of countries (including Australia), changes towards chip phonecards are inevitable but will proceed slowly.



Cover story: Marilyn Monroe

Marilyn Monroe phonecards and stamps excite fans

today at New York's Planet Hollywood on January 5 when actress. Marilyn Monroe, was showcased during the premier viewing of a new postage stamp to be issued in her honour by the United States Postal Service.

Postmaster General, Marvin Runyon, unveiled the US stamp design featured on this month's cover, which will add 400 million images of Marilyn Monroe to the already formidable celluloid record that immortalises one of Hollywood's most glamorous stars.

"Today, more than 30 years after her death, Marilyn Monroe's humour still makes us laugh, and her smile still stirs our hearts," said Runyon. "There is only one Marilyn."

Prior to her death on August 5, 1962, Marilyn Monroe completed a legacy of 29 films.


Among them were big box-office successes like The Seven Year Itch, How to Marry a Millionaire, Some Like it Hot, The Misfits, and Gentlemen Prefer Blondes.

She epitomised Hollywood glamour in its golden age, when klleg lights against the Los Angeles sky signaled the premiere of the next box office smash and the accompanying parties were shared with all of America via movie magazines and gossip columns.

Also Runyon announced that the Marilyn Monroe commemorative stamp is the first in a new series called Legends of Hollywood. Similar

T was "lights, camera, action" to the very popular Legends of American Music series, Legends of Hollywood will showcase individuals who made a major impact on the development of American films, which are recognised and applauded worldwide.

Of the 40,000 or more suggestions for stamp subjects received by the Postal Service each year, only about 25-30 are selected, making an appearance on a US postage stamp a unique privilege and honour in American life.

The stamp image was designed by award-winning artist, Michael Dees, who said, "Marilyn possessed a unique combination of sensuality and approachability.

"That's what I tried to capture for the stamp," he said.

MARILYN MONROE is also making her mark on telephone cards.Gem International in California is featuring Marilyn on a series of phonecards sold to access long-distance telephone services provided by Teltrust, Inc.

To date, there have been three Marilyn series issued by Gem. The first comprises four US\$10 cards, each showing a smiling Marilyn in a different pose, with the signature of photographer, George Barris, printed across each card.

The second series, comprising one \$10 card showing a black and white photograph of Marilyn featured in the New York Post and one \$20 card, showing a still from one of Marilyn's most popular movies, The Seven

The third and most recent series of Marilyn Monroe cards to come from Gem is the 1994/95 greeting set of three cards. A \$10 card wishes a "Merry Christmas"; a \$15 card offers "Seasons Greetings"; and a \$20 card, showing Marilyn with a champagne glass, wishes a "Happy New Year!". This series shows what are believed to be some of the rarest photographs ever taken of Marilyn Monroe. These pictures, taken by George Barris, came to light only recently and were given prominence in the October 1 and 2 1994 edition of the New York





Cheaper overseas calls for Australians?

USTRALIANS are being offered cheaper overseas calls through the competitive United States based networks, some of which offer phonecard type products. Others are accessed simply by quoting a credit card number. Still other networks offer a combination of both, issuing a type of phonecard with an account number and, for security, a PIN (personal identification number) - with customers "topping up" the call value available on their card by debiting a certain amount from their credit card.

An increasing number of Australians

(and overseas visitors) are taking advantage of cheaper calls offered by US-based companies known as "callback" service providers, including Telegroup and Mastercall.

The call back service providers are accessed by calling a 1 800 number.

It is claimed that calls to the USA and Europe may be as much as two-thirds cheaper than calls made via Australia's telephone networks.

Approximately A\$2 billion in calls are made each year from Australia to overseas numbers - suggesting that this market will be open for a lot of compe-

tition in the future.

Whilst there are clams of some abuses of the overseas call-back systems (such as debiting a credit card without delivering service), Austel, the Australian telecommunications regulatory authority, says that operators must register with it, but they do not require a licence.

Call-back has been banned in some countries, and the International Telecommunications Union (I.T.U.) is understood to be examining whether the activities of call-back service providers is needful of regulation.

Two-day fair

AUSTRALIAN INTERNATIONAL PHONECARD FAIR '95, to be held in Sydney in March, has been expanded to a two-day fair.

The fair was previously held over a weekend in conjunction with the Australian International Banknote Fair. Although phonecards were featured at the banknote fair and phonecard activity overwhelmed the banknote business, the phonecard fair was officially a one-day event.

Starting with the March fair in Sydney (March 25-26), it will be expanded to a two-day fair, and only phonecards and related phonecard memorabilia and ephemera will be sold at the fair.

The fair will be open to the public from 10am to 5pm on both days at the Wynyard and Margaret Rooms, Holiday Inn Menzies Hotel, 14 Carrington Street, Sydney, New South Wales.





Fundamentals

To begin with

by Danny Jurd

THE big question confronting a new phonecard collector is what to collect? Do you collect mint, used or whatever?

Over the past few years, one of the most popular styles of collecting for enthusiasts both here and in New Zealand has been the collection of Collector Packs.

Certainly as far as investment goes, this style of collecting has shown itself to be the most active area of the hobby.

Over the past year most of the Australian collector packs have increased in value in a big way.

Now prices are a little less stable and in a lot of cases have fallen, but they are still a solid collecting area and most prices are still well over double their levels of a year ago.

What is a collector pack?

A collector pack (also known as a collector edition) is a group or set of

phonecards that is offered in a nicely presented folder containing details on the cards and the scenes that they feature.

Australia's first collector edition was released when the Geelong trials were issued in 1989.

Initially, the cards that were issued in the packs and the cards that

were released for general sale were basically the same, in terms of prefix and so on.

However in the past year, Telecom has released packs that include cards that are only available in collector edition folders.

While the face of the cards may appear the same as the released product, the backs of the cards may have a different inscription such as

"Limited Collector Edition".

Thus, the only way to get such a card is to buy the collector edition. Illustrated on this page, it is easy to see how the backs of the cards differ.

This collecting style is a convenient and easy way to collect Australian Phonecards.

For people wishing to collect Australia's limited edition collector packs as they are released, a standing order can be placed directly with Telecom.

When it comes to older issues, most dealers, such as those advertising in this magazine stock a full range of collector packs.

However, not all Australian phonecards are released in collector edition packs.

Examples of this include the Generic issues - those

boring looking cards that featured a stylised telephone handset.

Only the \$5 from this series was put into a pack.

There are other examples as well, mostly advertising cards and the like.

Collectors wanting these will need to buy them loose.

There are other cards available in packs, but not from Telecom. These are the Custom Cards.

Custom cards

REGULAR readers of *Phonecard Collector* will have seen last month's column by Torsten Weller, in which he described the systems and philosophy behind Custom Cards.

Custom Cards are, as the name suggests, cards that are produced to order on behalf of either an individual or organisation.

These are produced for a variety of purposes, sometimes as a promotion for a company for their product, or primarily with the collector in mind

Those that are produced with the collector in mind are available from phonecard dealers.

Unlike Telecom's general release cards, custom cards are not generally available at face value. Why? you may ask.

To recap, custom cards have to be purchased from Telecom at face value (plus a premium for production) by the issuing party. They are usually packaged at further expense and in many cases, royalties are paid to the owners of the copyright on the images used. The result is a product which must be sold above face.

The first custom cards were produced last year for the Tamworth country music festival.

Since Tamworth, a good range of Custom cards has been produced, many of which are advertised in this magazine.

Images have ranged from Mickey Mouse to the first manned moonlanding. These cards are not only face different to Telecom's own general issue cards, but they have different features on the reverse as the illustrations below show..

So generally speaking you will not usually find Custom cards for sale at your newsagent and Telecom definitely does not handle sales of these cards.

However, in recent months, there have been instances were custom cards have been sold through local newsagencies.

These are just two of the ways that one can built up a worthwhile collec-

tion of phonecards.

All this column attempts is to give collectors some broad ideas to build upon, and maybe some basis guidelines to follow.

A difficult choice?

ONE of the reasons phonecard collecting is growing so fast as a hobby is the way it attracts young people. However, speaking as a "not so old person" myself, I remember well the problems associated with being young and having a hobby.

My number one problem was always money. As the old saying goes, I didn't have any money worries because I didn't have any money

to worry about!

So I am quite sympathetic when I see younger collectors coming into the shop I work at, looking at the more expensive cards and wishing they could afford them.

What's a young collector do? Saving is always a good idea, however, in the short term there is a solu-

Last month, I suggested readers consider the virtue of collecting fine examples of used phonecards whilst steering clear of scratched or otherwise damaged cards.

If I was a young collector and I couldn't afford to pay \$30 for a multihole \$50 Generic, but I had \$5 or so,

what should I do?

One school of thought suggests the exercise of patience, waiting for a good example at a more affordable

But, younger collectors often prefer to keep filling gaps to keep their interest bubbling.

So, in this case, buying a "second" as a temporary spacefiller may not be such a bad thing.

Most dealers will have a seconds board around their shop. There, you will find cards that are priced accord-

ing to their condition

This may just be a way to fill those gaps. But, be warned: Examine the card closely before you buy it, whilst being realistic enough to accept that, in view of its lower price, it may be far from perfect.

Gremlins

GREMLINS found their way into last month's column in which we illustrated two examples of the \$10 South Australia.

Captions for good and poor copies were transposed, as I am sure most readers would have realised!



Perth Mint news

A LL the Perth Mint's 1994 proof coin issues and other special issues for the year were sold out after being heavily oversubscribed.

The proof issues were of Australian Kangaroo Nuggets, Australian Koalas, Australian Kookaburras and three-metal sets.

One special issue was a series of four Kangaroo silver coins with privy marks on gold inserts of the effigies of the four British monarchs shown on gold sovereign coins produced at the Mint between 1899 and 1931.

Each of the coins in the series was released in conjunction with a coin fair conducted by the Numismatic Association of Australia (NAA).

The other special issue was a 15,000 coin issue for the Australian team for the Commonwealth Games held in Victoria, British Columbia, Canada last August. This issue helped raise funds for the team's expenses.

Goldcorp privatisation

THE Board of Gold Corporation made recommendations to the Western Australian Government last December about the Corporation's future.

Last May, the WA Government,

which is the Corporation's sole shareholder, invited expressions of interest in acquiring a minority interest in the organisation.

There were 13 expressions of interest received by the June 30 deadline and the Corporation subsequently held detailed discussions with three parties who, it was felt were best qualified to enhance the Corporation's activities in the long term

The report to the Government outlined all the options for the Corporation's future and made recommendations about them.

It is expected that the WA Cabinet will make a decision early in 1995.

The WA Government is not fully committed to the sale of a minority or any interest, but has been keen to review future options in the light of developments in the international precious metal industry.

If it decides to sell an interest, legislation would be required which would probably prolong the until the middle of 1995.

The WA Government has said that the driving factor behind the examination of its options was its desire to build on the success that had been achieved with the Corporation.

The issue that would weigh heavily in its decision-making was how an association between the Corporation and other organisation might "add value" to both operations.

Criteria identified as being of par-

ticular importance were:

- * increasing the expertise and level of activity in precious metals treasury and related foreign exchange dealings;
- * the potential for rationalising gold and refining in Australia and the nearby region; and
- * securing distribution channels for Gold Corporation's range of value added precious metals products.

The Government formed Gold Corporation in 1988 and based it on the historic Perth Mint which has been refining gold and manufacturing coinage since 1899.

Goldcorp in Indonesia

ESTERN AUSTRALIA's Gold Corporation has established a presence in Indonesia with the appointment of Marshall Cooper as its Commercial Manager for the country, effective last November 1.

Mr Cooper was formerly Commercial Services Manager for PT Kelian Equatorial Mining in Indonesia

He is operating from Jakarta with the aim of developing a wide range of services for the Indonesian mining and precious metals industries.

Indonesia gold production has grown rapidly in recent years, raising from 18 tonnes in 1991 to 46 tonnes in 1993.

Further increases will occur over the next few years. With a high economic growth rate and 180 million people, the country is also a potentially important market for precious metal products.

Why Australia's new polymer currency is the safest in the world

HILE Australia's counterfeiting problem is small by international standards, it is becoming more serious, given the availability of sophisticated print technology.

Almost five times more counterfeit paper notes were passed or seized in 1993 than in 1992. To date, no counterfiets of \$5 and \$10 polymer notes have surfaced.

Like the polymer \$5 and \$10 notes which preceded it, the new \$20 note issued on October 31 last year has many anti-counterfeiting devices in its design - the most prominent being a printed image of a compass. It is only with Australia's polymer technology that security devices like the window can be incorporated into notes.

Apart from better security, polymer notes provide other important benefits: they last much longer than paper notes and stay cleaner; and they can be recycled into various products, whereas paper notes cannot be recycled.

What makes the note more secure?

PUT simply, polymer enables the

Reserve Bank of Australia to incorporate new security devices into currency notes.

Another first is that, within the window, the denomination numerals have been embossed into the clear polymer substrate and they become visible as the note is tilted.

Also, within the window, an image of a compass has been printed which can be seen from either side of the

note.

Other security devices incorporated in the \$20 note include: raised print, which can be felt, is used for the portraits and other major design elements; microprinting incorporated in the design on either side of the note; intricate multi-coloured, fine line patterson; wghen the note is held up to the light, a seven pointed star within a circle is formed; and the Australian Coat of Arms is visible underneath other printing, similar to a watermark on paper notes.

If readers suspect they have a note which might be counterfeit, they should make contact with the local police or the Reserve Bank on \$\mathbb{2}\$ 008 633 220.







Astronaut Dave Scott - the first licensed lunar driver:

Roam Pacific gratefully acknowledges the participation of United States Astronaut, Dave Scott, in this, the second of Roam's Telecom Australia space phonecard series. With special thanks to NASA.

Astronaut, David Randolph Scott, the seventh human to walk on the moon, was born in San Antonio, Texas, on June 6 1932. A graduate of the US Military Academy, he was selected as astronaut in 1963 and piloted Gemini 8 (together with Neil Armstrong) and Apollo 9, the earth orbit test of the full Apollo spacecraft. As commander of the Apollo 15 mission, launched on July 26 1971, he landed the spacecraft on the moon's surface on August 7 1971 - the fourth manned moonlanding. Dave Scott and his pilot roamed the lunar surface for 6½ hours, using the first ever lunar rover.

The Apollo 15 series is unique in that it is only the second collector pack of Australian phonecards ever produced containing the full range of Telecom Australian denominations (\$2, \$5, \$10, \$20 and \$50). The first was Roam's Apollo 11 series. As of January 1995, due to a change in Telecom policy, all \$2 phonecards will bear the words "Complimentary Only", making this issue a rarity.
